This was the first meeting following the successful renewal ballot to agree immediate priorities for BID activity.

Marketing

- Current campaigns are focusing on businesses re-opening on 12th April. There is a specific hair & beauty campaign (being coordinated by BK) and a retail campaign (being coordinated by A-M D)
- Action: TS to conduct a survey regarding print what would businesses like to see produced in print?
- Action: TS to set up monthly meetings with Footprint to agree priorities and ensure that
 businesses know what marketing activity is taking place and how they can get involved.
 Campaigns should be developed around different consumer groups (young mums, retired,
 workers in the town, commuters, high net worth locals).
- Need to understand more about what local want eg Sunday opening, pre-cinema / theatre meal, late night opening click and collect, home delivery.
- Community engagement needs to increase as many of the larger businesses are focused on this area.

Digital Transformation

- The Business Plan including a proposal to subscribe to the Maybe platform which will enable
 individual businesses and the BID to see best practice examples, see what is working and
 have access to social media training. The subscription is £195 per month. Action: TS to
 proceed.
- Action: TS to explore Save the High Street resources / projects.

An Attractive Town

- Action: TS to explore co funding opportunities for improvements.
- Action: TS to explore rotating brackets for hanging baskets 90 degrees so that they are more visible.

Business Communication / engagement

• Action: TS to set up monthly zoom drop in sessions for businesses
