

#### Musings of a musician

IF I had been born in the 1930s, I might have had the chance to meet the great Leo Fender, founder of the giant Fender Musical Instruments Corporation. Leo, along with a few trusted associates, developed the first mass produced all-solid-wood electric guitars in 1950s California. Leo was a visionary and he wanted to give working musicians the right tools for the job. He changed the world we live in. Without Leo Fender, I would not be a musician.

Luckily for me I was born within a decade of Mr Paul Reed Smith, founder and CEO of Paul Reed Smith Guitars. Paul began honing his exceptional skills as a repair man in the 70s, fixing classic guitars from the 50s and 60s. A highly curious and energetic young man, he began building guitars in an effort to create something truly special. By the early 80s he was known to elite guitar players, many asking Paul to build them one of his superb instruments. As a teenager in the mid 80s, I too became aware of PRS Guitars as they began making appearances on TV shows, album covers and guitar magazines.

Just recently, I was invited to attend an audience with Paul at Guitor Guitar in London. Paul has been busy once again launching new guitars in the never ending pursuit of the perfect instrument. The ideal tool for the working musician.

So who is this enigmatic Southern gent from Maryland? I knew from the many YouTube clips I had watched that Paul is a big talker. He is an excellent lecturer and expert on the subject matter; he is also hilarious and friendly. A man who has devoted his working life to improving his craft and providing the world's best instruments.

The electric guitar is a feat of ingenuity, theoretical physics, artistry and passion. Paul is a master of all four disciplines. I got to meet the Leo Fender of our time.



## Attractive Town

- Regular weeding of pavements / pruning of trees

- Potted trees at key points on Station Road East & West
- Lighting up Master Park plane tree by memorial/roundabout
- Funding of roundabout streetlamp
- Continue to fund Christmas lights (+ upgrade)
- Christmas trees throughout the town

### Improvements

- Rotary Clock repair
- Improvement of Oxted Station:
  - Refurbishment of station tunnel entrance (porch)
  - Planters at front of station (extension of hanging baskets / tubs)
- Assessment of shop front electrics and assistance with removal of old festoon lighting
