Great games for kids and parents

- 1. Pin the Tail on the Bunny This Easter game for kids is just like the classic pin the tail on the donkey, except you'll use cotton balls with tape on them rather than a donkey tail.
- 2. Egg Bowling This traditional Easter game calls for one dyed or coloured-in, hard-boiled egg per child and one plain hard-boiled egg. Roll the plain one into the centre of a room and take turns to see who can roll their coloured egg closest to the white egg.
- 3. Easter Egg Memory Use coloured plastic cups or egg cups and place over pairs of same coloured mini eggs. Take turns flipping them one at a time, and see who can match up the most pairs. You get to eat them after!
- 4. Easter hop game (same as sack race). Players have to hop to the finish line. Best results wearing bunny ears...
- 5. Easter Bunny Tag Everyone knows how to play tag or "it". This game is played in the same fashion, except everyone must hop. If you don't hop, then you're automatically "it."
- 6. [gg and spoon race played with patterned hard-boiled eggs or chocolate easter eggs (creme eggs etc)
- 7. [gg Catch (play OUTSIDE!!!) Played in pairs. [ach pair faces each other at a starting line and is given one egg. The person with the egg throws it to the person without it. With each throw, each person takes a large step backward. This continues until they reach an end mark and return to the starting line with an unbroken egg. If a team drops an egg and the egg breaks, they're out of the game.
- 8. Egg Roll Each person gets a hard-boiled egg and a hockey stick or bat and stands at the starting line. The egg is placed on the ground and pushed to the finish line with a stick. The hockey stick must stay below waist level, and the egg can't crack or break. The first one to the finish line wins.





The fourth little rabbit went jump, jump, jump.


The fifth little rabbit yawned and went to sleep, sleep!
